

## Landisville Pool 2020 Covid-19 Plan for Yellow Phase Opening June 15, 2020

- **New Pool Hours are Noon – 7 pm** (additional time required for proper cleaning & disinfection)
- Members Only **NO GUESTS** until further notice.
- Six feet **social distancing required** in all common areas including check-in and when exiting the pool
- No social events such as 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Raft Night, Burger Night, etc. until further notice.
- Covid-19 Signage will be posted in breezeway.
- **PLEASE READ & follow posted guidelines** for self-assessment upon daily entry.
  - Parents are responsible for their children's daily self-assessment, please review the posted procedure.
- Adult Members will be required to sign an Assumption of Risk Waiver of Liability relating to Covid-19
  - Form may be completed in person on Sun. June 14<sup>th</sup> Noon – 3 pm at pool entrance and Mon. June 15<sup>th</sup> during pool hours.
- **Snack Bar & Water Fountain are CLOSED** however there will be a drink and snack vending machine. You may also bring your own food and drink as well.
- Grills will no longer be available for member use.
- No tables, chairs, or benches. Members may **bring your own chair**.
- No Pavilion Rentals or use of Picnic Tables
- Toilet & Changing facilities will be available; however, **NO showers**.
- Hand Sanitizer will be provided within the facility. (We encourage you to also bring your own personal supply).
- Face mask strongly suggested per CDC guidelines in common spaces and when entering and exiting the facility.
- It is recommended **NO** face masks are worn while in the pool.
- Basketball & Volleyball Courts will be open, no loaner balls supplied, you may bring your own for court use.
- Other games, books, goggles, nose clips, and toys will not be provided. Please bring your own.

### Staff & Lifeguards

- All **employees & staff** will be educated on Covid-19 guidelines & procedures.
- Before each shift, employees & staff are required to adhere to the posted Self-assessment procedure.
- Employees will wear a mask when having direct contact with the members. Lifeguards will not be required to wear a mask while talking with staff or members within a safe distance.
- All employees will follow social distancing.
- In case of an emergency involving mouth to mouth resuscitation, guards will use a barrier device.

### Daily

- Staff will announce guideline as a reminder, several times throughout the day via PA system.
- Restrooms will be disinfected frequently.
- Front Desk area will be disinfected frequently.
- Any member not following posted guidelines will be asked to leave the facility & risk membership revocation.
